Department of Economics, University of Pune: MA in Economics Admission Process:

Applications are now available for M.A. in Economics in the Department (For Regular students)

Kindly click on Admissions on the Pune University's Homepage. You will find the application for MA (in all subjects) online. Download it and print it. Fill it up and attach the necessary documents – 10th ,12th and graduation certificates with mark-sheets duly attested and the DD. Kindly submit the application plus DD to the Department of Economics, Ambedkar Bhavan, IInd Floor University of Pune on or before 10 July 2014

Eligibility: Graduates in Economics as well as other streams with 50% at graduation (open category) and 45% (reserve category) are eligible to apply.

Reservation: The Department follows the University's reservation policy. Candidates other than Pune University graduates have a 30% seat quota.

Important Dates:

Last date of application submission: 10th July 2014

<u>Dates of Personal Interviews:</u> 17th and 18th July 2014 beginning from 11.00 in the morning. (The interview schedule will be notified on the website by 15th July 2014)

Tentative Date of Declaration of Entrance Test: 25th July 2014

Beginning of Classes of semester I: 1 August 2014

The Entrance Procedure: There are personal interviews of each candidate (50 % of the entrance test marks) and the applicant's marks only in Economics at graduation. (the other 50% of the entrance test marks). For example, if you have received 30 marks in the personal interview out of 50 and if you have secured 70% marks at BA in economics subjects, we will

take 30 marks of your interview and add half of your BA marks i.e. 35 to it, your total score will then be 65 out of 100 and the admission merit list will be prepared with these 65 marks for you. When all the interviews are over, a Departmental Committee prepares the final list of admission with 50% reservation rules applied. We have 50 seats available. We usually ask BA level economics in the personal interviews.
